CHEMICAL SPLASH	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Rinse affected area immediately with water for 15 minutes.2. Seek medical attention.
NON- EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Notify supervisor.2. Proceed to: Concentra Medical Center 120 Lytton Avenue, Suite 275 412-621-5430 <p>During non-business hours seek treatment at UPMC Presbyterian Emergency Room.</p>
CHEMICAL SPILL	<p>Evaluate spill:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. If flammable, highly toxic, or large, evacuate area and call 412-624-2121.2. If incidental, contain spill. Neutralize or absorb spilled material. Dispose of cleanup materials via Chemical Waste Program. If necessary, contact EH&S (412-624-9505) for assistance.3. If radioactive materials are involved, call Radiation Safety at 412-624-2728
FIRE	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Alert others in immediate danger and close door.2. Pull alarm.3. Evacuate using stairs.
UPON HEARING BUILDING ALARM	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. If possible, prepare lab for evacuation by shutting off gas, securing experiments, capping containers.2. Close lab doors.3. Evacuate using stairs.4. Move away from building and entrances. Reassemble in K or G Lot. <p>The long term evacuation site for Chevron is Alumni Hall</p>
